

Barn Rules

1. **No feeding or petting of horses that you do not own.** You may pet any school horse and give them treats with the instructor's permission. Do not feed horses by hand. Please place treats in the horses feed trough or use a bucket found in the tack room used for this purpose.
2. **No Running is allowed at the barn.** This is because some horses spook and try to run when they are frightened. It could make for a dangerous situation.
3. **No Screaming or yelling.** Horses have much better ears than people and are very sensitive to loud noises.
4. **No playing on the mounting block, ramp or hitching post.** No climbing on any of the fences. Please do not play in the barn areas or in the hay barn.
5. **Park in designated areas only.** We have been asked to park at the turn out (Small arena) at the north entrance of the property. Parking at the tack room area is for instructors and special needs clients only.
6. **Students must wear helmets at all times when around horses.** This includes haltering, tacking and putting away horses. Loner helmets are available in the tack room if needed.
7. **Students must wear boots** when riding. Loaner boots are available in the tack room if needed.
8. **No dogs are allowed on the property.**
9. All areas behind the white fences around the brick house are private. Please do not play in these areas.
